- Preparing for the new school year at our local day schools with new technology, additional staff, and accommodations for social distancing


WE FACILITATE JEWISH EXPERIENCES AND CONNECTIONS



This crisis sparked a dramatic increase in inquiries to food pantries and an urgent need for food deliveries

- Providing funds and resources to fight rapidly spreading food insecurity
 - Demand at area food pantries increased by up to 50%
 - Home delivered meals up by 14%
- Delivering more than 4,000 meals to elderly community members since March

- Providing funds and resources to help beneficiary agencies maintain critical services and programs
- Securing over \$17 million in loans and grants for eligible community organizations
- Responding to the community's questions and concerns through Access Jewish Cleveland

WE KEEP OUR COMMUNITY SAFE AND RESILIENT

- Continuing to provide security to Jewish Cleveland through our security provider, JFC Security, LLC
- 30 guards are currently deployed around the community
- Working closely with other organizations in the community that combat all forms of hate – including anti-Israel and anti-Semitism – through educational and bridge building opportunities
- Developing a voting rights policy that advocates for safe and accessible elections during the pandemic
